Background of the Department of Agricultural Extension and Rural Development (AER)

The Department of Agricultural Extension and Rural Development is one of the largest Departments of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural University (BSMRAU) under the Faculty of Agriculture, established in 1992 along with other 10 old departments. The department has been offering graduate program leading to MS and PhD degrees.

Through interaction with farmers, the department teaches the application of new insights and scientific research in agricultural field. In addition to the primary aim of providing higher education in this specialized field, this department is assisting, collaborating and providing services to teaching, research and outreach staffs in designing and developing instructional material to improve their efforts in education, outreach and dissemination of research information.

Research facilities are available in Extension and Rural Development using the farmers' situation as a social laboratory. Major research thrusts are identifying constraints to agro-rural development including ecosystem service management as well as sustainable agriculture related issues, developing alternative extension methods, strategies and approaches and extension teaching methods and techniques. Besides, the adoption and diffusion of agricultural innovations and their sociocultural barriers along with the development of feedback mechanism on farmers' reactions to new technologies are also the prime research areas of this department. Moreover, several other research areas have also been focused by this Department, including, utilizations of GIS in agricultural-extension, precision agriculture including good agricultural practices, research on higher education quality improvement, and also agriculture policy related issues.

The Department has nine (09) prominent faculty members with sound academic, teaching and research background, comprising 5 (five) Professors, 2 (two) Associate Professors, and 2 (two) Assistant Professors. The outstanding performances of the faculty members have placed this Department on a unique position which is supported by more than 350 published articles, more than 2000 citations in different researches, awarding 34 PhD and 202 MS degree, so far. Due to strong academic, research and alumni association activities, the Department of Agricultural Extension and Rural Development might be No. 1 choice of many previous and prospective students.



It gives me immense pleasure that under the able leadership of some Departmental teachers of AER and particularly the singular efforts of Dr. Afrad, my long-felt Alumni dream is going to come true. A meeting is going to be held on 22/07/23 to make some strategic plans and tactical efforts in this connection. May Almighty bless all the innovators and their noble undertakings. My good wishes and prayers are for all of you.

We often have dreams in our life, but seldom have they come into effect. Fortunate are those who experience some of their dreams come true. Thank Almighty, I am one of these few ones who have this experience. While I was at BAU, I dreamed for the leadership development of Rotaract Club member. Virtually, I took the all-out efforts for the development of Rotaractors' Training Camp (RTC) at Rotaract club of Agri-varsity. It is a nation-wide program of the Rotaract clubs of Bangladesh now. I had also the dream of developing the teaching techniques of BAU teachers, after I had exposure in this regard from the USA and UK in the mid'80s. With all-out hindrances from BAU teachers, Dr. Halim and I uphold this banner and arranged Training of Trainer (TOT) for some young teachers of BAU at a very small scale. But the impact created by TOT of GTI during my time was perhaps the most outstanding. Over a decade, it played the most dominant role throughout the country. I am grateful to God that this blessings were with me all the time to fulfill my dream. I always nurtured it with affection.

My last dream was to form an AER alumni at BSMRAU when I retired from my active service in 2011. I wanted to refresh my beautiful memories as Adjunct Faculty, Head and visiting professor of AER, BSMRAU. The issue was discussed with some departmental teachers and also some AER PhD holders. Although many showed interest but could not make it happen due to many lapses. The only exception was Dr. Afrad who kept it blazing in his mind all the time. In the meantime, my wife and I came to USA in 2017 and the COVID pandemic kept us away from our normal works from 2020 till 2022. But even then when I came to Bangladesh in vacations, I kept myself informed about it from Dr. Afrad. I am glad to hear that the Department of Agricultural Extension and Rural Development, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Agricultural University (BSMRAU), is going to organize the first annual general meeting of its Alumni Association since the establishment of the Department in 1992 along with other 10 Departments. As a former Rector of the then Institute of Post Graduate Studies in Agriculture (IPSA now BSMRAU), I specially congratulate the organizing committee for initiating this Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the newly established Alumni Association of the Department.

Through this message, I am also pleased to let others know that in the then East Pakistan, I was the first student and only one student who got admitted to pursue his M.Sc. in Extension Education in 1966 in the then Department of Agricultural Extension and Teachers' Training under the Faculty of Agriculture, Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU), Mymensingh. This Department was a new Department of BAU and also the nomenclature of the degree was quite unknown to all of us. So, taking risk but with hope and aspiration, I took the role of an innovator to get admission in this unknown Department and in a new degree program. I was advised by many not to get admission in this Master's program except two teachers of this Department named late Prof. Dr. Serajul Islam Bhuiyan (Head of the Dept.) and late Prof. Dr. Anwarul Karim. Before registration to this subject, I finally, approached to the then Vice-Chancellor of BAU late Dr. S.D. Chowdhury to get his opinion. He was very happy as I went to seek his opinion. He inspired me very much and explained the prospects of this new professional field. Anyway, there are several other stories on this issue which I wrote in another article published by the Graduate Training Institute (GTI) of BAU. New students were scared for getting admission in this Department of BAU until the duration of the M.Sc. Program was cut down to one year in 1970.

The above short background of the initial status of Agricultural Extension as a discipline indicates how difficult it was to establish this subject as an academic degree offering subject for the growth and development of Agriculture. Even when I was appointed on deputation as Rector of the then IPSA in 1995, I heard that some teachers of IPSA objected to establish the Agricultural Extension and Rural Development Department. They wanted to offer this subject by the Department of Agronomy without establishing this new Department. But now, I myself and all others are proud of this Department for taking leading role in teaching, research and providing services to the community at home and abroad.

Thanks to the Alumni Association, especially Prof. Dr. Afrad who asked me to write a message for this august occasion and for invitation on behalf of the Department.

Finally, I appreciate Prof. Dr. Md. Giashuddin Miah, Vice- Chancellor, BSMRAU for providing all necessary cooperation and logistics in organizing this important event as a first of its kind at the Departmental level of this prestigious university providing leadership at home and abroad.

At the end, I hope that BSMRAU will initiate extending services and conduct rural development activities involving students in the course, especially around the university. The department of Agricultural Extension and Rural Development may take leadership in the program.


